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Name of Organization: Buddhist Wing Yan School

Goal: To nurture students' language proficiency and self-learning skill through learning Short Stories with Phonics.

Objectives:

- To design a phonic curriculum that can be integrated into school-based English curriculum
- To develop a series of Short Stories that incorporates phonics to arouse students' learning motivation
- To build a Phonics Courseware to provide multi-sensory stimulation for learning and efficient monitoring
- To boost professional development in integrating Phonics and IT for effective language teaching and learning
- To motivate parents' active learning, support and monitoring in Language Learning of students
