

Project Title: **Basic Law Education Project (BLE Project) (Teaching and Learning: National Education)**

Name of Organization: Centre for Citizenship Education (CCE), Hong Kong Institute of Education

- (1) **Goals:** To cultivate a culture of respecting the Basic Law (BL), the rule of law and human rights (HRs);
 To study and strengthen students' understanding of the BL, rule of law, HRs;
 To study and strengthen teachers' understanding of the BL, rule of law, HRs;
 To provide training to teachers on directions and strategies in BLE; and
 To study a human rights-friendly school environment.

(2) **Expected number of beneficiaries**

8 secondary schools will participate. About 400 teachers will receive training and 3000 students will benefit.

All teachers in Hong Kong may benefit from the web-based resource centre and the dissemination seminars.

(3) **Implementation Plan : Project period: 1 May 2009 – 30 April 2011**

(The project will contain 2 phases, each of which will take one year and involve four schools.)
