# Part B - Project Summary

(I) Goals:

Our school, Concordia Lutheran School – North Point (CLSNP) has 'holistic education' as its philosophy. Through taking an active part in the English musical, students' language proficiency, multiple intelligences and exposure to performing arts would be enhanced.
