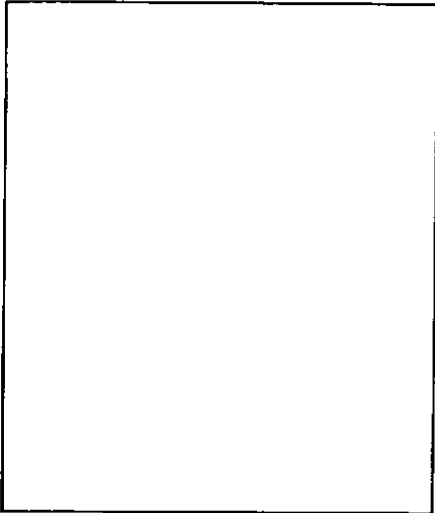

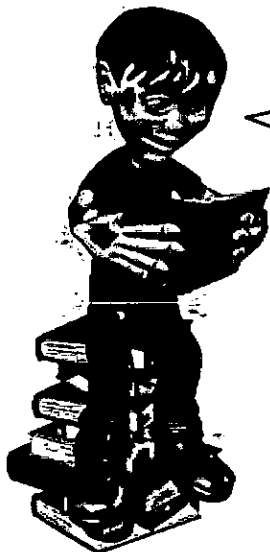

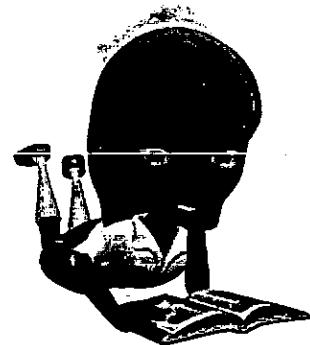

Rules and guidelines

- ◆ You are encouraged to read different types of books and articles.
- ◆ You will receive reading materials from your class teacher on some days of the week and you may borrow books from class librarians on other days.
- ◆ You are encouraged to always have a book as a backup so you will have something to read.
- ◆ You are encouraged to donate books to your class if you have old books or good books from home.
- ◆ You will need to fill in the Reading Booklet during each reading lesson. The teacher will verify your reading record daily.
- ◆ You are strongly recommended to give short remarks on the materials read such as 'like' or 'dislike'.
- ◆ Your class teacher will give a chop to reward you under their observation.
- ◆ Students must be quiet during the reading lesson.
- ◆ No student is allowed to do his or her homework during the lesson.
- ◆ You need to **PAY** for the full fee of the book if you do not return it or if it is missing.
- ◆ Students are allowed to borrow books after the reading lesson but they must sign-out with the class librarian.

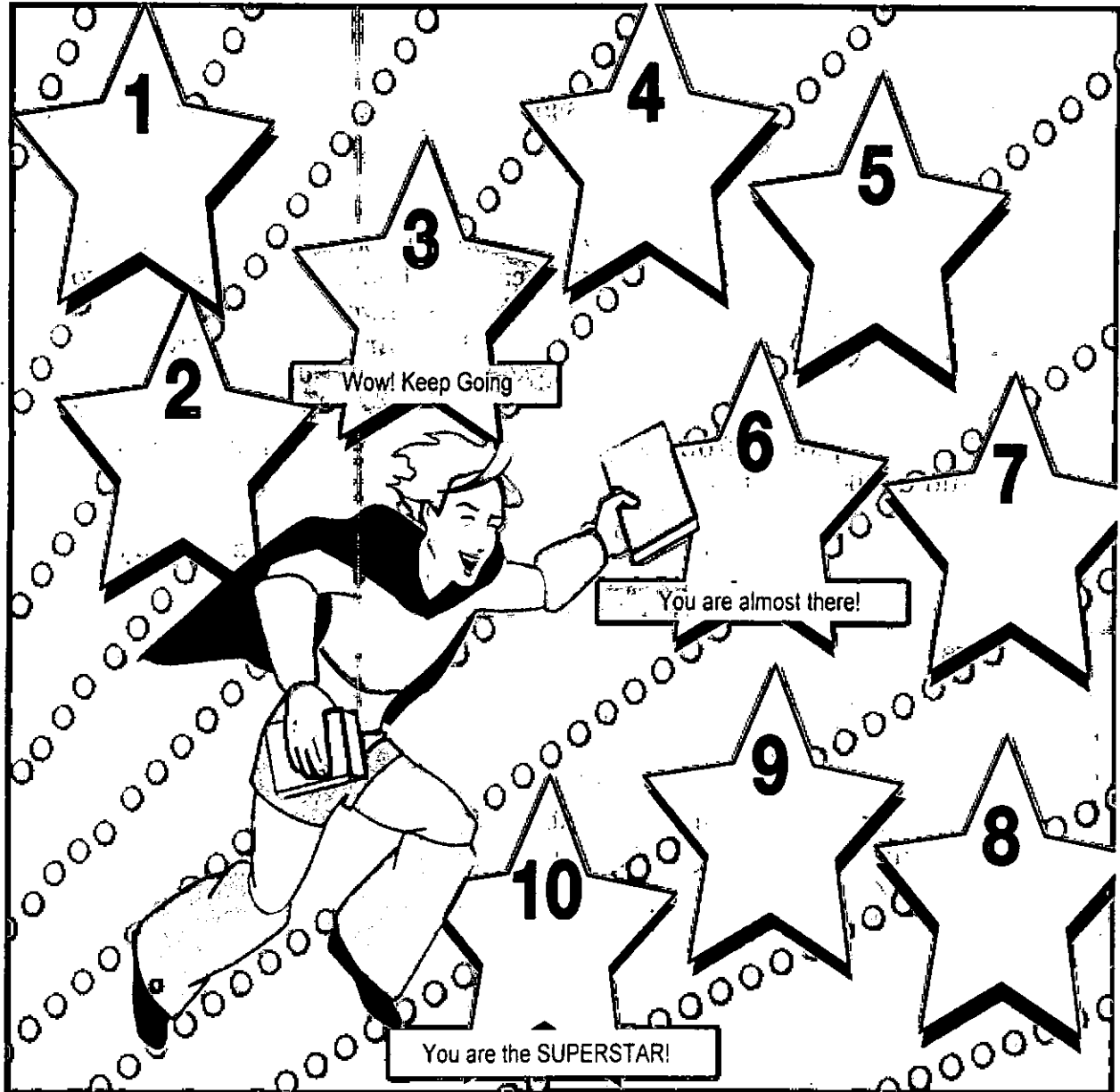

Step 1:

Use the following scale and tables to record all the books you have read. You are requested to write a brief comment on the feelings about the book you have read. Once you have finished reading a whole book, ask your parents to sign to show them your success!

Step 2:

Show your class teacher the signature of your parent, and he/she will ask you to illustrate that you have read the book. For **each task** you will receive **5 marks** in addition to the **base mark** for reading a book from group 1-5 in the reading scheme. Here are some fun things you can do:

- Share the plot in front of the class; tell you classmates what you like and dislike, the plot and if you advise them to read your book
- Do a book report on the book; write about the plot summary and feelings
- Draw a picture, compose a song; create a bookmark; or make a poster of the memorable characters in the book
- Perform a little skit or drama with your classmates and have fun!
- Any other activities are acceptable if approved by your class teacher, so be creative and ask them!

Final Step!

Once you have completed the task above, your class teacher will give you a chop and record your success. The student with the most chops in their class each month will have their picture posted on the school website and a **GRAND** prize from the reading scheme committee. So start reading!


