

**Part B: Project Summary****1) Introduction**

- Title: Careers Education Program – Bringing Future into Focus
- Objective: (1) To help students judge more accurately what type of occupation they are likely to find satisfying. (2) To help students understand the range of occupations available to them and the routes they can follow to achieve their aims. (3) To help students develop strategies for decision-making in careers choices. (4) To help students develop strategies for the planning of their on-going educational path. (5) To create a sustainable development environment for teachers to establish a continuous process of careers education through a systematic model. (6) To enhance communication and cooperation among parents, students and the school for the better implementation of the careers education.
- Direct beneficiary: (1) All SS1, SS2 & S6 students (no.: 470, 2010/11). (2) All parents of SS1, SS2 & S6 (no.: 470, 2010/11). (3) All teachers (no.: 70). Total no. of beneficiary: 1010.
- Indirect beneficiary: Project sharing with other schools

**2) Content:**

- Series of decision making and strategic planning skills and related training workshops would be conducted by experienced trainers with the assistance of our teachers to foster various kinds of learning and thinking capacities of the NSS students. Moreover, teachers and parents would also participate in training workshops so as to grasp the basic concepts with the intention to put theory into practice so as to reinforce what students have learnt.
- Four phrases of implementation from Feb. 2011 to Jan. 2012. Then, there would be program evaluation in Dec. 2011 and project dissemination from Dec. 2011 to Jan. 2012.
