#### 4. Areas of Support

This QTN aims at:

- Encouraging schools to promote positive education and culture so as to cultivate a positive attitude among children towards learning and life;
- Assisting schools to strengthen school-family partnership to foster whole child development; and
- Promoting professional sharing through networking different schools for capacity building of teachers and schools to establish a professional school network.

# 5. Foci of Support

- Assist the schools to establish the Positive Education culture:
- Enhance teachers' understanding on how to foster whole child development through positive education;
- Enhance children's positive attitudes towards learning and actively engage in learning;
- Promote school-family partnership and alert parents the importance of positive education in order to facilitate whole-child development; and
- Encourage experience sharing among teachers by building professional learning communities.

#### **6.** Modes of Support

- Workshops for school leaders and teachers conducted by university professors, school development team and external frontline consultants;
- Regular on-site visits by school development team (12-months support) :
  - The supported member schools are:
    - ♦ Core School (approximately 15 visits);
    - ♦ Partner School (approximately 10 visits); and

- ♦ Network School (approximately 5 visits).
- Major aims:
  - → Help the Core Schools to establish positive education school culture and school-based curriculum to promote whole child development;
  - ★ Enhance school experience of the Partner Schools developed in the 2018-2019 QTN project; and
  - → Facilitate experience sharing activities of the Network Schools.
- Workshops for parents where parents can work with teachers to learn the importance of positive education which also helps foster parent-school partnership;
- Offshore visits for Core Schools and Partner Schools where they can learn experiences from overseas counterparts; and
- Professional learning communities through clustered professional sharing activities for schools

#### 7. Points to be noted by Participating Schools

To make the best use of the support services, participating schools are required to:

- Form a core project team with at least 2 to 3 teachers and assign one teacher-in-charge to liaise with the university project team;
- Be open and receptive to external professional support;
- Have very strong commitment in promoting positive education curriculum and school culture for whole-child development;
- Provide administrative facilitation such as arranging time for discussion, collegial module planning and peer classroom observations;
- Upload the case of school-based positive education development to the project website for sharing with project schools;
- Establish a school portfolio showing project progress and reflections for knowledge management and experience sharing;
- Be willing to share with teachers within and outside schools for building professional learning community;
- Observe strictly their legal obligations, in all cases, comply with Copyright Ordinance in developing school-based experience sharing materials; and
- Attend two Executive Committee (EC) meetings and an annual dissemination seminar to share the good practices derived and challenges faced.
